







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#### THE AUSTRIAN NATIONAL NODE OF BBMRI-ERIC






"Gaps in the data on which algorithms are trained can likewise automate existing patterns of discrimination, as machine learning systems are only as good as the data that is fed to them."



Data should include:


- Various disease types and comorbidities


