The DNA samples of around 230,000 Finns have already been compiled in a biobank and researchers from FinnGen want to double this number. The samples shall be used for geneteic screening of 100,000 genetic tags. FinnGen has a budget of around 60 million euros and receives funding from the public funding agency Business Finland and seven pharmaceutical firms: Abbvie, AstraZeneca, Biogen, Celgene, Genentech, Merck & Co. and Pfizer.
